1. How many branches are there in the menorah of the Holy Temple?
There are seven branches (Numbers 8:1)
2. Who did the Levites replace in their service in the Ohel Moed (Tent of Meeting)?
They replaced the first-born Israelites (Numbers 8:17-18)
3. What went with Bnei Yisrael in the desert during the day to protect them?
A cloud (9:15)
4. And what went with Bnei Yisrael in desert at night?
A pillar of fire (9:15)
5. What did God ask Moshe to make to summon Bnei Yisrael?
2 trumpets made of silver (10:1)
6. What did Bnei Yisrael eat in the desert?
Manna (11:7)
7. What did Bnei Yisrael eat in Egypt?
Fish, cucumbers, melons, leeks, onions and garlic (11:5)
8. How many days did God send quail for?
One month (11:19)
9. How many elders did Moshe gather up?
Seventy (11:16)
10. What punishment did Miriam receive from God?
Tzora'at (snow-white scales) (12:10)
